This new book tells the story of the village and its neighbours - Turn, Stubbins, Irwell Vale and Ewood Bridge - from the end of the 18th century to the present day. Arranged in thematic chapters, it looks at changes in housing and the local landscape; how people made a living from farming, textiles, quarrying and coal mining, shop keeping and inn-keeping; how they were educated; how they spent their leisure time and the important part that the different churches played in the life of the communities. There is also a chapter on village life during the two World Wars.

Running to more than 300 pages, this hardback book is well illustrated with photographs, maps, and contemporary documents, many of which are published for the first time.
